Jesus made this very clear when He spoke of our judgment in Matthew 25:34-40, "Then shall the King say unto them on His right hand, 'Come, ye blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world: For I was an hungered, and ye gave Me meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave Me drink: I was a stranger, and ye took Me in: Naked, and ye clothed Me: I was sick, and ye visited Me: I was in prison, and ye came unto Me.' Then shall the righteous answer Him, saying, 'Lord, when saw we Thee an hungered, and fed *Thee*? Or thirsty, and gave *Thee* drink? When saw we Thee a stranger, and took *Thee* in? Or naked, and

clothed *Thee*? Or when saw we Thee sick, or in prison, and came unto Thee?’ And the King shall answer and say unto them, ‘Verily I say unto you, **Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these My brethren, ye have done it unto Me.**’”

A brother or a sister of Jesus Christ is one who has God’s Holy Spirit!

Notice, if we help our brothers and sisters physically, and especially spiritually, we are doing this service to Jesus Christ Himself! Many of our Christian brothers and sisters are hungry and thirsty spiritually! Numerous ones are starving to death because there is a Spiritual famine in this land! Others have become disorientated and have wandered from the body of Christ. We need to find them, bind up their wounds, and give them nourishing, Spiritual food so they can regain their Spiritual health and strength.

That is the purpose of this ministry! We have left the corporate, mega, denominational churches and their ways to seek and to find the ones that have been left alone in this world of spiritual confusion.

Jesus, “...said to His disciples, ‘The harvest truly *is* plentiful, but the laborers *are* few. Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest” (Matt. 9:37-38 NKJV).

Are you willing to be like James, the brother of Jesus? He explained the deeds of a true disciple of Jesus Christ this way, “Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone. Yea, a man may say, ‘Thou hast faith, and I have works:’ ‘Show me thy faith without thy works, and I will show thee my faith by my works’” (Jas. 2:17-18).

We are saved by faith through the sacrificial work of Jesus Christ, but **our judgment will be determined by our works**. Please notice Revelation 2:23, “...I am He which searcheth the reins and hearts: and I will give unto every one of you according to your works.”

Jesus has said to some Christians, “...I know thy works, that thou hast a name that thou livest, and art dead” (Rev. 3:1). Some that carry the name of Jesus Christ—Christians say they belong to God, but they do not have the Spirit of God within them! I pray that this is not speaking of any of you! The Spirit of God in us will strongly want to respond to the work the Father is doing!
