“Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God” (Rom. 8:26-27 NKJV).

Many times we, as Christians, don't know how to pray as we ought. Our lives become so complicated that we have difficulty knowing where to begin our petitions to God. God knows and understands our plight. The key for us is to begin! If we just start, the Spirit will help us pray.

We must confess our sins and our weaknesses. If we draw nearer to God in repentance and humility, He will come closer to us. The key is to yield to the Holy Spirit and desire, with all our hearts, to obey the Word of God as we are given direction.

As the Holy Spirit opens our minds to understand the truth, we must respond in obedience. If we don't obey what we are shown, our understanding will cease. “Take heed therefore how ye hear: for whosoever hath, to him shall be given; and whosoever hath not, from him shall be taken even that which he seemeth to have” (Luke 8:18).

Spiritual knowledge and understanding are linked to our obedience. The more we obey, the better will be our understanding.

Continue to ask God for the guidance of the Holy Spirit so you can grow more and more in the knowledge of His Son Jesus Christ. A humble, heartfelt prayer is the place to begin building a rich relationship with God.
