“The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do *His commandments*...”

Psalm 111:10

Have you ever wanted greater Godly wisdom and understanding? All this begins with a deep reverence for God.

Our respect and appreciation is shown by our actions. If we obey God and do as we are instructed, our wisdom and understanding will grow.

The Spirit of wisdom and understanding is given to them who obey God, “And we are His witnesses of these things; and *so is* also the Holy Ghost [Spirit], whom God hath given to them that obey Him” (Acts 5:32). Our depth of understanding of the Word of God is determined by our willingness to obey the things we are taught. As we humble ourselves before the Word of God, we will grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. It is by, and through, the Holy Spirit that Godly wisdom and understanding are given. The Holy Spirit helps us to understand the Word.

“Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation” (II Pet. 1:20). Human intellect alone will not give you understanding of the Bible. It is the Holy Spirit that will lead you into all truth. “But the Comforter, *which is* the Holy Ghost [Spirit], whom the Father will send in My name, He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you” (John 14:26). Without the Holy Spirit to guide you in the study of the Word, you will not be able to find Truth.

Human wisdom and Godly wisdom are quite different; as a matter of fact, they have nothing in common. We are told in the book of James that, “...if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth. This wisdom descendeth not from above, but *is* earthly, sensual, devilish” (Jas. 3:14-15).

On the other hand, “[Godly] ...wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, *and* easy to be entreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace” (Jas. 3:17-18).

So we learn that, in order to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit, it is important to be willing to humble ourselves before God and obey His Word. It is not enough to hear the Word. We must obey and do what we are taught.
